

Internal Sound Engineer Input Chart







Wheelhouse External Sound Engineer Input Chart

As Numbered on Stage Plot


- Male Vox 1 Steve: Vocal Microphone

- 4 Guitar 1 Fender Stratocaster Mike: Amp Microphone
- Guitar 2 Fender Telecaster Danny: Amp Microphone
- Guitar 3 Taylor Acoustic Danny: Amp Microphone
- **Keyboards (2) Hammond & Yamaha Mox8** Bill: DI or Amp Microphone and Vocal Microphone
- Bass Guitar Musicman Stingray 5 Tom: DI
- **Drums DW** Kirby: 6 Microphones in Drums Kick, Snare, Floor Tom, Left & Right Toms; 2 Overheads and External Hi-Hat; 9 Channels Total; Floor Snake to Board (DI)
















Wheelhouse Internal Sound Engineer Input Diagram

The Monitor Number must match the Speak-On patch portal number. (Otherwise the mixer operator will be confused!)


















Hard Wired Microphone Connection



All 5 connections are via snake matching numbers.




Channels 6, 7, and 8 can be used for other purposes as needed.




A thru D are returns.



Power Cord




VERY IMPORTANT: Speakon cables are NOT used in this configuration. The sound signal is conveyed from unit to unit by the XLR cables. The signal goes into the INPUT female XLR plug, and is conveyed to the next unit from the THRU male XLR plug.



VERY IMPORTANT: This is a PowerCon cable connection; NOT a Speakon. Do not confuse.
